From our diagramming we see that there are four important verbs (one is actually implied), and thus four main ideas. 1) Do not swear. 2) Let your yes be yes. 3) Let you no be no (the verb is implied in the Greek text). 4) The final verb is the end result of the previous verbs; you will not fall under judgment. Next time we will form an analytical outline that will detail this more clearly.
